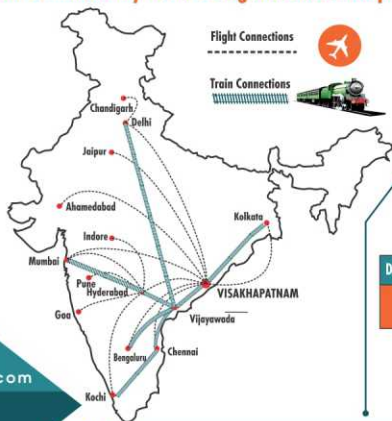

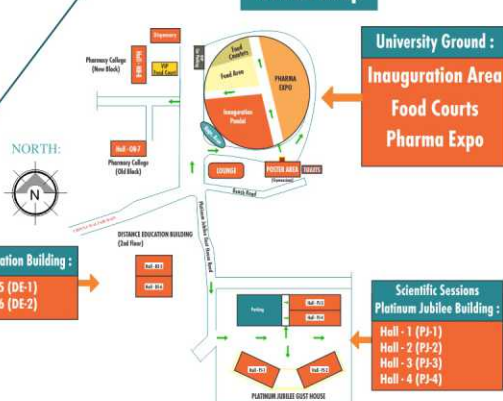
ROUTE MAP



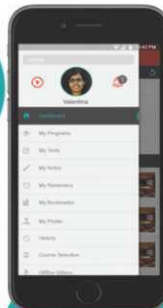
