# Scientific Guidelines

## Guidelines for Abstract Submission :

- ◆ Abstracts should be submitted through **online** from the website.
- ◆ The word count for abstract is 300 words (from Aim to Conclusion)
- ◆ Abstract should be structured and should contain Title, Authors Name, Institutional affiliation, Aim, Methodology, Results, Conclusion and 3 Keywords.
- ◆ No Figures, Graphs and Tables are allowed in the Abstract.
- ◆ The abstracts should be checked for plagiarism before submitting.
- ◆ Only one presenting author is allowed for presentation in the conference & the certificate of presentation will be provided to the same person.
- ◆ The presenting authors are requested to register themselves well in advance. No spot registration will be entertained for presenting authors.
- ◆ Kindly prepare your abstract in MS word file, Double space, Times New Roman font (Title Font Size 14 & Running Font Size 12) with justified alignment.
- ◆ The MS word file size should not be more than 1 MB.

## Oral Presentation Guidelines :

- ◆ Presentation should be prepared in Power Point using the 4:3 standard slide setting.
- ◆ Presentation Allocated Time: Presentation 7 mins/Q & A 3 mins. MS-Power Point (\*.ppt) presentations are preferred.
- ◆ Pictures and animations linked to the Internet or to other files will NOT be accessible.
- ◆ The selected abstracts for Oral Presentations are selected by the Scientific Committee and intimated to the candidates through e-mail.

## e-Poster Guidelines :

- ◆ An e-poster is an electronic version/PDF of a poster presentation. The e-poster may include text, figures, charts, tables, images and artwork.
- ◆ The e-posters will be displayed in the e-posters zones. The e-poster area will consist of four large screens.
- ◆ One screen will display a rolling slideshow of all e-posters that specifically apply to the 'categories' of that day.
- ◆ We advise that the author should be present near the e-poster area for the duration of your poster viewing slot, on the appropriate day, in order to answer questions from fellow delegates.
- ◆ Font type: use Times New Roman or Arial.
- ◆ File Size: Maximum file size is 2.5 Megabytes (2.5MB).
- ◆ File Format: Save your file as a PDF for quick and easy upload.

- ◆ Must be 35 or less than as on December 31st, 2019
- ◆ Young Scientist Award category is open to all
- ◆ Number of papers published in indexed journals (Scopus, Web of Science and Pubmed)
- ◆ Candidates applying for the award category cannot present an e-poster or oral presentation.
- ◆ A brief biodata must include the 10 best papers with its reference in Vancouver style

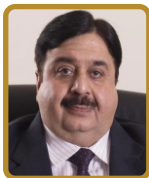

## Kadri Manjunath Temple :

The temple of Manjunatheshwara on the hills of Kadri is a very beautiful and popular temple in Mangalore. It is said to be built during the 10th or 11th century. It was converted to a complete stone structure during the 14th century.



## Gokarnanatheshwara Temple :

The Gokarnanatheshwara Temple, otherwise known as Kudroli Sri Gokarnanatha Kshetra, is in the Kudroli area of Mangalore in Karnataka, India. It was consecrated by Narayana Guru. It is dedicated to Gokarnanatha, a form of Lord Shiva. This temple was built in 1912 by Adhyaksha HoigeBazar Koragappas from Hindu epics and

## Shree Mangaladevi Temple

The Mangaladevi Temple is a Hindu temple at Bolara in the city of Mangalore situated about three km southwest of the city centre. The temple is dedicated to Hindu god Shakti in the form of Mangaladevi.



### Pilikula Nisarga Dhama :

Pilikula Nisarga Dhama is about 12 km from the city and is a tourist spot with "Manasa" water theme park, animal park, boating, science centre, arboretum, golf course etc., all in one place.



Murdeswar Temple: 149 km. Murdeswar is famous for the world's second tallest Shiva statue, the town lies on the coast of the Arabian Sea and is also famous for the Murdeswar Temple. This temple is built on the Kanduka Hill which is surrounded on three sides by the waters of the Arabian Sea.



### Panambur Beach :

Panambur Beach is in Panambur, 10 km to the north of the city, Near the New Mangalore Port and along the Confluence of the Gurupur River and the Arabian Sea. This is comparatively more deserted and is a great spot for safe and secluded swimming. Panambur is well connected by bus and can also be reached by auto rickshaw from the city centre.



Malpe Beach and St Mary's Island – 54 kms St. Mary's Islands, also known as Coconut Island and Thonsepar, are a set of four small islands in the Arabian Sea off the coast of Malpe in Udupi, Karnataka, India.

### St. Aloysius Chapel :

St. Aloysius Chapel in Mangalore was built by the Jesuit Missionaries in 1880 and its interiors painted by the Italian Jesuit Antonio Moscheni in 1899, during the Mangalore Mission in 1878. The interior of the chapel is decorated with paintings by Antonio Moscheni (1854–1905) that cover almost all of the walls, which is unusual in chapels in India.



### Ullal Darga:

Ullal is famous for Darga of the Saint Syed Mohammad Sherifulla Madani. It is also known as Ullal Jamma Masjid and it is a famous pilgrim centre for the Muslims. Syed Mohammed Shareefulla Madani Darga is the tomb of the soofi who came from Medina in 1569.
