- Abstracts (Maximum 300 words) must be submitted via email to **clinicalpharmacy.astermedcity@asterhospital.com** on or before 15.09.2021.
- Abstract Topic – "Pharmacovigilance: A step towards Patient Safety"
- Presenting author's contact details (should be the same details as the submitting author so that the presenting author receives the correspondence about the abstract)
 - Email address
 - Full postal address
- Author and co-authors' details
 - Full first and family name(s)
 - Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country
- Abstract title - limited to 20 words in UPPER CASE
- Abstract text – limited to 300 words
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.
- The presenting author must be listed as the first author.
 - Submitted abstracts should include non-published data.
 - Abstracts previously presented will not be accepted.

-All abstracts should be submitted and presented in clear English with accurate grammar and spelling.

- You can submit only 1 abstract.
- Abstracts may not be edited/updated after final submission.
- The Committee will review all submitted abstracts. Notification regarding abstract acceptance and scheduling will be sent to the submitting author.
- Selected candidates should be prepared for an onboard oral presentation of 15 minutes duration.
