3. Beetroot Gel, a herbal cosmetic formulation was developed and the technology was transferred to M/S Sree Herbals, Coonoor.
4. Curcumin Gel, a herbal cosmetic formulation was developed and the technology was transferred to M/S Sree Herbals, Coonoor.
